**What are the criteria for eligible scarecrows?**

We ask only that Scarecrows be hand-made and family friendly. **Absolutely no political scarecrows allowed!**

**What is the scarecrow entry deadline?**

October 15th at 6:00pm

**How are the winners in each category determined?**

By vote of public by paper ballot obtained dropped off at the Chamber of Commerce. One vote per person, please.

**Are there display criteria for downtown businesses?**

- We ask that Scarecrows be displayed in front of the business, preferably outside, or in front window for best viewing.
- Outside Scarecrows should not extend to the sidewalk from the front of the building, similar to a bench or flower container.

**What are the prizes for winners?**

A picture of you and your scarecrow in the news, online and social media, a certificate, and bragging rights!
